ACTION TAKEN:

In response to the allegations to the alleged crimes at Rajneeshpuram by Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh on September 16, 1985, a multi-agency task force was formed to investigate specific crimes. Participating agencies were the Federal Bureau of Investigation, U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS), U.S. Customs Service, Wasco County Sheriff's Office, The Dalles Police Department, Jefferson County Sheriff's Office, the Oregon Department of Justice, and the Oregon State Police.
